



2022-23 academic year: New ESSCA campus to open in the heart of a European capital

In July 2021, ESSCA School of Management formally announced the creation of <u>a new</u> <u>campus in France</u>, in Strasbourg. A triple crown-accredited school of management, ESSCA will roll out a series of post-secondary, degree-granting training programmes, it's Bachelor programme and Master's-level Grande Ecole programme from the beginning of the 2022-23 academic year on its new campus. Already firmly established in France in Angers, Aix-en-Provence, Bordeaux, Lyon and Paris, the School will be opening its latest premises within the "espace européen de l'entreprise" in Schiltigheim, thereby creating closer links with the various regional ecosystems.

In line with the targets sets by the Odyssée 20/24 strategic plan, ESSCA commits to offering among the very best working, research and learning conditions in European higher education by 2030.



A new institution in the heart of Europe

The new campus is being established in the heart of the "espace européen de l'entreprise" in Schiltigheim, one of the largest tertiary and innovation industrial estates, in the Alsace region. The area brings together a host of teaching and research institutions, including ECAM Strasbourg-Europe, the CNRS campus, Charles de Foucauld High School, and the Louis Pasteur University Institute of Technology.

This **stimulating environment** has been specifically chosen to formalise exchanges between companies, institutions, and students in the tertiary and digital fields. Located to the north-west of the city in the inner suburbs, **the campus will be within easy reach** of the mainline train station and city centre, both of which are just a 15-minute connection away from the school.

The **1200m**², single-storey ESSCA premises comprise 7 classrooms and workspaces, a student hall of residence, and rooms dedicated to association life, as well as an on-site catering service.



Future staff and teachers on the campus will be able to take full advantage of the **school's** academic and organisational know-how, as well as the teaching and research dynamics of a faculty that currently totals 157 teacher-researchers.

The school will offer two training programmes from the beginning of the 2022-23 academic year:

- 1st year Bachelor in International Management: 30 places
- 1st year <u>Grande Ecole Programme</u>: 30 places

Registration will be open via **Parcoursup** until 29th March 2022.

A meeting will be held on Saturday 19th March, from 10am to 5pm at the Palais de la musique et des congrès de Strasbourg, aimed at high school pupils and their families wishing to obtain further information.
